



Colors:


Purple - Royalty. Our students will understand their worth and Kingdom Identity



School villages can choose a brick and mortar building, fully online, or hybrid model.

CSGN provides the district support needed for school operations guidance, structure, academic program, fundraising, and more.

SCHOOL VILLAGES WILL PROVIDE

- A schoolhouse (building)/Online Platform
- A Champion of education to lead the program
- A partnership agreement with Christian Schooling Global Network
- To stay within compliance of "All" established protocols of "School Villages".
- To lead the enrollment efforts of the school village with the assistance of the network
- To lead the promotion of the school village in collaboration with CSGN
- To assist with local fundraising and donor outreach







ABOUT FUNDING

- -CSGN and the School Village will collaborate to raise funds to assist with tuition assistance.
- -Our funding formula covers the operational expenses collected by student tuition.
- -School developers pay an application and the launch process fee of \$499.00. (The launch process is 3, 6, or 10 months)
- -Once the schools open, the school village will pay 7% of the total student tuition for business district office services.
- -Full list of benefits provided by the CSGN district office are listed on the next slide.

SERVICES PROVIDED BY CSGN



- -1. Equip & walk with each school village in establishing their school program from conception to launch.
- -2. Provide the curriculum and assessment program for grades PreK4 thru 12th grade.
- -3. Work in collaboration with the school village to provide fundraising and secure donors for students who need tuition assistance.

- -4. Provide the Student Management System that will manage admissions, enrollment, and more.
- -5. Ensure compliance with state protocols for parochial schools are followed.
- -6. Recommend and provide guidance for the Safe Schools Program.
- -7. Provide the student/parent, and employee handbooks, and other related literature.
- -8. Provide Professional Development for educators/staff.

- -9. Setup and oversee payroll, employee taxes, insurance portal for all staff hired by the school village.
- -10. Assist the school in setting up the food and transportation program.
- -11. Provide bell schedules, school calendar, school forms, and daily operational guidance as needed.
- -12. Provide guidance for establishing the code of conduct program.
- -13. Provide legal coverage and resources for the school village.
- -14. Walk with the school village through the five domains of becoming a flourishing school.
