



#### **Colors:**


Purple - Royalty. Our students will understand their worth and Kingdom Identity

\*Note, ACSI, membership acceptance is based on the guidelines of ACSI member processing.













## SCHOOL VILLAGE MODEL

A School Village is a private Christian school

CSGN partners with school villages to provide a Christ-centered education to children.

CSGN supports the following school models, in person, fully online, or hybrid.

CSGN provides the initial support in setting up a Christian school, the frame work, structure, and guidance to open.

#### **SCHOOL VILLAGES WILL PROVIDE**

- A schoolhouse (building)/Online Platform
- A Champion of education to lead the program
- A partnership agreement with Christian
   Schooling Global Network
- To stay within compliance of "All" established protocols of "School Villages".
- To lead the enrollment efforts of the school village with the assistance of the network
- To lead the promotion of the school village in collaboration with CSGN
- To assist with local fundraising and donor outreach



# SERVICES PROVIDED BY CSGN



- -1. Equip & walk with each school village in establishing their school program from conception to launch.
- -2. Provide the curriculum and assessment program for grades PreK4 thru 12th grade with our school partner with full accreditation.
- -3. Work in collaboration with the school village in fundraising and connecting to secure donors for students who need tuition assistance.

- -4. Provide the Student
  Management System that
  will manage admissions,
  enrollment, and more.
- -5. Ensure compliance with state protocols for parochial schools are followed.
- -6. Recommend and provide guidance for the Safe Schools Program.
- -7. Provide the student/parent, and employee handbooks, and other related literature.
- -8. Provide Professional Development for educators/staff with our educational partner.

- -9. Provide support in setting up the HR department to include payroll.
- -10. Assist the school in setting up the food and transportation program.
- -11. Provide support in establishing the bell schedules, school calendar, school forms, and daily operational guidance.
- -12. Provide guidance for establishing the code of conduct program.
- -13. Provide access to legal coverage and resources for the school village through Legal Defense Alliance.
- -14. Walk with the school village through a 6 -12 month school launch journey.
